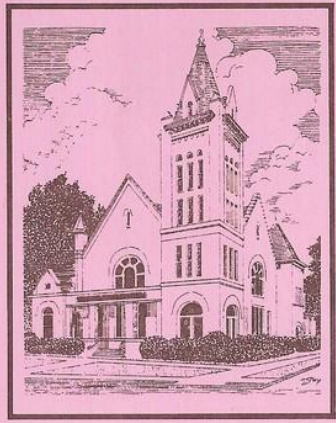

The Society conducts HERITAGE TOURS, arranges and/or provides guides for special tours, presents programs to groups, and serves as an information source.

HAHS MUSEUM is located in Hattiesburg's downtown Nationally Registered Historic District and is staffed by volunteer members.
